TRAUMA OF POVERTY

The American Academy of Pediatrics considers experiencing poverty to be an Adverse Childhood Experience. One in three children lives in poverty. With this comes limited access to needed resources, stigma and unearned shame. Poverty is not a personal failing, it a result of inequality, oppression and policy choices. Worcester Community Action Council is here to help people move to economic self-sufficiency through programs, partnerships, and advocacy. Maydee will share some innovative strategies that are seeing promising results!



Maydee Morales is the Director of the Resiliency Center and a 2024 Erskine award winner. She is well known in Worcester and beyond for calling out injustice and serving the needs of underserved and underrepresented individuals and families. Prior to her role at WCAC, she was the Director of social services at Catholic Charities of Worcester County. She has been at the forefront of addressing critical needs- helping establish a women's shelter during the pandemic, responding to Hurricane Maria and assisting new immigrants and refugees in recovering from the trauma they have endured.
